Note: Aid cannot be disbursed until the requested documentation is received and reviewed. Please check Argo Express for missing requirements.

What we need from you:

- This completed worksheet signed by the student and parent
- Signed 2017 tax return transcript from the IRS for all tax filers including student and parent(s)
- **OR** a signed 2017 1040 for all tax filers including student and parent(s)
- **OR** successful completion of the IRS Data Retrieval within the FAFSA (instructions below)
- If the student and/or parent did not file taxes, please also complete the non-tax filing form

IRS Data Retrieval Steps

Login to your FAFSA. Proceed to the Financial Information Tab. If you are eligible, you will see an option to "Link to IRS." Click this option and Proceed to the IRS Site. Enter the requested information exactly as it appears on your tax return, and click submit. Click the option to "Transfer Now." This step will need to be completed by both the student and parent, if applicable. The data retrieval option may not be available to all FAFSA filers.

List below the people in the parent's household. Include:

- The student.
- The parents (including a stepparent) even if the student doesn't live with the parents.
- The parents' other children that they provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020, or if the other children would be required to provide parental information when completing a FAFSA for 2019-2020, even if the child does not live with the parent.
