Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- High school or college GPA is greater than 3.0
- Accepted for admission or currently enrolled at the University of Providence
- Will be enrolled at University of Providence in 2021
- Personal interview required in January 2021

To apply, please submit the following:

- This completed application form.
- Letter of personal recommendation from a pastor, associate pastor, parish employee, or campus minister.
- Letter of academic recommendation from a counselor, principal or teacher.
- Resume of service and/or leadership demonstrating participation in parish, school or service organizations, or individual efforts.
- An essay of at least 500 words on **one** of the following prompts:
 - The shared mission of all Providence ministries reads: *As expressions of God's healing love, witnessed through the ministry of Jesus, we are steadfast in serving all, especially those who are poor and vulnerable.* How do you see yourself as an expression of God's healing love? How do you allow your Catholic faith to guide your life of service to God and others?
 - As a Catholic University founded by the Sisters of Providence, the University of Providence is called to continue the teaching ministry of Jesus Christ in the world today by calling students to be a manifestation of God's love for the world. Why is a Catholic higher education important to you? How do you see yourself contributing to the mission and Catholic identity of the University of Providence?

If selected as a Catholic Scholar, the following expectations are required to maintain the scholarship:

Campus Involvement requirements

- Live in campus housing as a resident student of the University for all four years of the scholarship period.
- Participation in Campus Ministry sponsored events and worship services and encouragement of other students to participate.
- Participation in community service opportunities through Campus Ministry.

Academic requirements

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester and a 3.0 GPA overall. Students whose GPAs fall below 3.0 cumulative are placed on scholarship probation. Failure to maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA may result in the loss of the scholarship.
- Catholic Scholars must be enrolled continuously as full time students (at least 12 credits per semester.)
- The Catholic Scholar award is renewable each year for four years. Catholic Scholar funds may not be used toward summer session tuition or for more than 18 credits per semester.

Other requirement

- Completion of the FAFSA each academic year no later than March 1.
