- **OR** a signed 2019 1040 for student and spouse, if applicable
- **OR** successful completion of the IRS Data Retrieval within the FAFSA (instructions below)
- If the student and/or spouse did not file taxes, please also complete the non-tax filing form

**IRS Data Retrieval Steps**

Login to your FAFSA. Proceed to the Financial Information Tab. If you are eligible, you will see an option to "Link to IRS." Click this option and Proceed to the IRS Site. Enter the requested information exactly as it appears on your tax return, and click submit. Click the option to "Transfer Now." The data retrieval option may not be available to all FAFSA filers.
