Deadline for submission: December 15, 2022. Interviews will be scheduled in January 2023.

Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- High school GPA is greater than 3.0.
- Accepted for admission to the University of Providence beginning Fall 2023 with the intent to enroll.
- Personal interview required in January 2023.
- Renewable until 120 credits met, extenuating circumstances will be reviewed by committee on case by case basis.
- Demonstrated involvement in clubs, activities, or service outside of academics.

To apply, please submit the following:

- Completed application form
- Resume of service and/or leadership demonstrating participation in school or service organizations, or individual efforts
- Professional letter of recommendation from a non-relative that can attest to your leadership abilities.
- An essay of at least 500 words on **one** of the following prompts:
 - Describe the solutions you would propose to improve or resolve a current issue, such as those involving health care, the economy, discrimination, or a current topic of your choice.
 - Explain how your involvement in school or community organizations has influenced your decision to pursue your intended major and how completion of your degree will help you make a meaningful impact in your community in your professional life.

If selected as a University of Providence Scholar, the following expectations are required to maintain the scholarship:

Campus Involvement requirements

- Live on campus as a resident student of the University. Special circumstances to the housing requirement may be reviewed on a case by case basis.
- Documented involvement in a campus club or organization, or in leadership roles such as Peer Mentor, Resident Advisor for campus housing, academic tutor, or other approved campus service experience. Involvement in off campus organizations is strongly encouraged.

Academic requirements

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester and a 3.0 GPA overall. Students whose GPA falls below 3.0 cumulative GPA are placed on scholarship probation for one semester. Failure to maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA after probationary period may result in the loss of the scholarship.
- University of Providence Scholars must be enrolled continuously as full time students (at least 12 credits per semester.)
- The University of Providence Scholar award is renewable each year until 120 credits are met. University of Providence Scholar funds may not be used toward summer session tuition or for more than 18 credits per semester.

Other requirement

- Completion of the FAFSA or the FAFSA non-filing form each academic year.
