### This Week of Lent

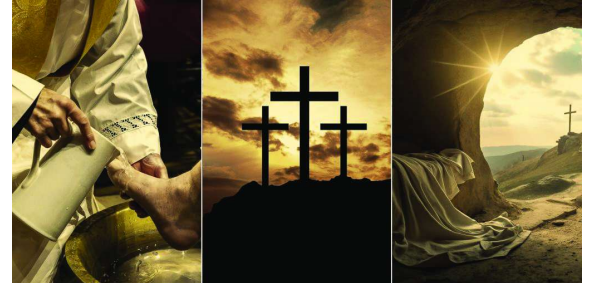


Sixth Station:

**Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>  
at 6:00 pm Stations  
of the Cross.** Come  
to Providence Plaza  
as we walk the way  
Jesus walked on his  
way to Calvary. We will begin by the  
Student Center outside the coffee  
shop area. We will be using  
Maryknoll's *The Way Continues*. The  
stations last around 30 minutes.



- We enter into Holy Week starting with Palm Sunday (March 29<sup>th</sup>). Part of Holy Week is the celebration of the **Sacred Triduum**.



Beginning with Holy Thursday (April 2<sup>nd</sup>) we enter into three days of one continuous liturgy of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. While we will only have Easter Sunday Mass here at Trinitas Chapel at 11 am, Campus Ministry will be offering rides to the other services. Here is the schedule: *Holy Thursday*, Our Lady of Lourdes @ 6 pm. *Good Friday*, Holy Spirit @ 3 pm and *Holy Saturday* (Easter Vigil), St. Ann's Cathedral @ 8:30 pm.

Each day we will meet 20 minutes before the Mass or service begins at the Sullivan Hall parking lot (by the statue of St. Joseph with the missing thumb). Make plans to attend. The Sacred Triduum is the most beautiful communal prayer of the Church year. You will grow in faith as we gather to enter into the Lord's passion, death and resurrection.



Next Sunday, March 29<sup>th</sup> is Palm Sunday. We will gather at the gates of our "Jerusalem" (Trinitas Chapel). We will begin outside (weather permitting) for the blessing of palms and the procession.


